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• PREFACE

This release note contains information about Mozilla Firefox 10 Support.

This package contains the following files:

- This release note
- InstallFirefox10Extension_32bit.vbs
- InstallFirefox10Extension_64bit.vbs

• LIMITATIONS

- The AccessStudio element finder does not work with Mozilla Firefox ESR 10.
- The action **Simulate keyboard input** does not work.

• KNOWN ISSUES

When a user logs on to AccessAgent while Mozilla Firefox ESR 10 is open, Mozilla Firefox ESR 10 crashes.

Workaround: Install iFix 5.

• INSTALLATION AND CONFIGURATION

Before you begin: Make sure you have Administrator privileges.

1. Close Mozilla Firefox ESR 10.
2. Run the VBScript corresponding to your Windows platform version.

For 32-bit Windows

cscript InstallFirefox10Extension_32bit.vbs

For 64-bit Windows

```
cscript InstallFirefox10Extension_64bit.vbs
```

Note: A popup window is displayed upon successful installation or when an error occurs. If you do not want this behavior, run the VBScript with the `--quiet` argument. For example:

```
cscript InstallFirefox10Extension_64bit.vbs --quiet
```

3. Start Mozilla Firefox ESR 10, it will ask for a confirmation to install the add-on.
4. Check **Allow this installation**.
5. Click **Continue**.
6. Restart Mozilla Firefox ESR 10.
